6. Both were crippled since birth, neither asked to be healed, both were told to stand up, both were instantly healed and could walk and even leap
7. Jupiter & Mercury
8. They tore their clothes and said “We’re men like you”
9. God send rain and the blessings of seasons, etc.; creation is a witness of God
10. In verse 18 they wanted to worship them as gods and in verse 19 they stone him and leave him for dead!
11. yes, a man stoned to the point of being left for dead is not likely to get up, walk back to town and be ready to travel the next day!
12. They encouraged the believers, gave them more instruction, set up churches and committed them to the Lord
13. They gathered all of the church members and gave a report about their work and especially about the work among the Gentiles.
