

# DANIEL

## (22) The (2) Resurrections

**Dan 12:2-4**

2 And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. 3 And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever. 4 But you, Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase."

**Rev 20:1-6**

Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain. 2 And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, 3 and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while. 4 Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. 5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years. *ESV (added)*

**God delivers the righteous and judges the wicked, Dan.12:1b-4**

From 12:1-2 what might we presume about the timing of the (2) resurrections?

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What does the detailed truth (NT) of the timing disclose? **Rev.20:1-6**

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So, in reality, what is Dan.12:1-2 really covering? See **Dan.9:24-27, Gen.3:15**

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But even this detail seems to 'jump over' what resurrection? **1Thess.4:13-18; 1Cor.15:51-57**

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What's for the 'wise'? 12:3; **Mt.19:27-30; Lu.22:24-30; 1Cor.6:1-3; Rev.20:4-6**

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What's for the resurrected wicked? 12:2b; **Mt.7:21-27; Rev.20:7-15**

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What is Daniel to do *after* the revelation? 12:4; **(time of the end) 11:40, 45; 12:1, 4, 6, 9, 13**

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Since God hides/reveals truth of the Word, what was Daniel's role? **Jer.32:1-15, note vs.14**

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**God delivers the righteous and judges the wicked, Dan.12:1b-4**

From 12:1-2 what might we presume about the timing of the (2) resurrections?

**It could be that both are simultaneous w/ the delivery of 'your people'. But... not true.**

What does the detailed truth (NT) of the timing disclose? **Rev.20:1-6**

**The 1<sup>st</sup> resurrection is post-trib/pre-millennial. The 'rest of the dead' is post-millennial.**

So, in reality, what is Dan.12:1-2 really covering? See **Dan.9:24-27, Gen.3:15**

**In one sentence it spans the 1,000 year millennial. Righteous, pre-trib;wicked, post-mil.**

But even this detail seems to 'jump over' what resurrection? **1Thess.4:13-18; 1Cor.15:51-57**

**The rapture of the church. Those who are 'in Christ'. Rapture is history after Rev.4:1**

What's for the 'wise'? 12:3; **Mt.19:27-30; Lu.22:24-30; 1Cor.6:1-3; Rev.20:4-6**

**They will sit on thrones and rule/reign w/Christ as priests. Also as judges of Israel.**

What's for the resurrected wicked? 12:2b; **Mt.7:21-27; Rev.20:7-15**

**They will stand condemned before Christ, judged by the record of their deeds. No life!**

What is Daniel to do after the revelation? 12:4; **(time of the end) 11:40, 45; 12:1, 4, 6, 9, 13**

**Shut up the words and seal the book UNTIL the time of the end. Written to/for Jews!**

Since God hides/reveals truth of the Word, what was Daniel's role? **Jer.32:1-15, note vs.14**

**Document signed/sealed/witnessed and stored 'for a long time'. Preserved for nation!**
