

Amazing Grace

(4) Our Holy God

Isa 6:1-7

1. In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.

2 Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

3 And one called out to another and said,

"Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts, The whole earth is full of His glory."

4 And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke.

5 Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts."

6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. 7 He touched my mouth with it and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips, and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven." NASU (Emphasis added)

Sinful man before the Holy God...Isa.6:1-7

When Isaiah sees a vision of the Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, what's his response? Isa.6:5

How does John react to seeing the resurrected Jesus? Rev.1:9-17a see Jn.19:25-27

What is the amazing grace extended to Isaiah and John? Isa.6:7; Rev.1:17-18

What does this mean to you? How does it impact you?

The amazing grace of our Holy God...Rom.5

When do we see the first record of God's amazing grace toward sinners? Gen.3:15

Was this promise just a reaction to their sin? Mt.25:34; IPet.1:17-21; Eph.1:3-4; Rev.13:8

How does Paul describe believers prior to our salvation? Rom.5:6-10; Eph.2:1, 12

But what happened '...at the right time..'? 5:6; Gal.4:4-5

When Paul sees believers, he sees us *standing* in something. What is it? 5:1-2

What are the Scriptural adjectives applied to Grace? Acts 4:33; IICor.9:14,12:9; IPet.4:10, 5:12; James 4:6 (Note: Grace appears 10 times in OT; 122 times in NT!)

So what is one thing that's amazing about this grace, in which we stand? Rom.5:8

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Sinful man before the Holy God...Isa.6:1-7

When Isaiah sees a vision of the Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, what's his response? Isa.6:5

He is devastated by his own sin. Woe is me! Just seeing the King, the Lord of hosts.

How does John react to seeing the resurrected Jesus? Rev.1:9-17a see Jn.19:25-27

He fell at His feet like a dead man! And this is 'the disciple whom He loved'.

What is the amazing grace extended to Isaiah and John? Isa.6:7; Rev.1:17-18

Don't be afraid! Your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven! Amazing Grace!!

What does this mean to you? How does it impact you?

The amazing grace of our Holy God...Rom.5

When do we see the first record of God's amazing grace toward sinners? Gen.3:15

God could justly abandon mankind but He graciously promises 'her seed', Jesus.

Was this promise just a reaction to their sin? Mt.25:34; IPet.1:17-21; Eph.1:3-4; Rev.13:8

No. The Redeemer (and the redeemed) were planned before the world was created!

How does Paul describe believers prior to our salvation? Rom.5:6-10; Eph.2:1, 12

We were helpless, ungodly, yet sinners, we were enemies. Dead in trespasses and sin.

But what happened '...at the right time..'? 5:6; Gal.4:4-5

Christ died for the ungodly. He demonstrates His own love toward us. Reconciled to Him!

When Paul sees believers, he sees us *standing* in something. What is it? 5:1-2

He sees us standing in Grace! Standing is abiding in, with firmness and stability. Grace.

What are the Scriptural adjectives applied to Grace? Acts 4:33; IICor.9:14,12:9; IPet.4:10, 5:12; James 4:6 (Note: Grace appears 10 times in OT; 122 times in NT!)

Abundant, surpassing, sufficient, manifold, greater, true Grace. Not many required!
