

# *I Timothy*

## (15) Fight the Good Fight

1 Tim 6:11-21

*But flee from these things, you man of God, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness. 12 Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. 13 I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate, 14 that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 which He will bring about at the proper time – He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, 16 who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen.*

*17 Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy. 18 Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, 19 storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.*

*20 O Timothy, guard what has been entrusted to you, avoiding worldly and empty chatter and the opposing arguments of what is falsely called "knowledge" – 21 which some have professed and thus gone astray from the faith. Grace be with you. NASU*

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What is the powerful image commanded in 6:12a? 1:18; ICor.9:25-26; Eph.6:10-18; IITim.4:7

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Why does Paul tell Timothy to 'take hold of eternal life'? 6:12,19; Col.3:1-2; Phil.3:20-21

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Of what is Paul reminding Timothy by '...you were called...good confession'? 6:12b; IITim.1:9

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What does Paul repeat in 6:13-14a? 5:21; IITim.2:14, 4:1

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How is he to keep these commands? For *how long*? 6:14b; Eph.5:27; IIPet.3:14

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When will Jesus appear? 6:15a What crescendo is added next? 6:15-16; Rev.1:8,17-18

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### **Paul's final instructions...6:17-21**

What command is given to Timothy now? 6:17; James 1:10; IJn.3:17

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What else are the wealthy instructed to do? 6:18; Gal.6:10; Heb.13:16; IPet.3:8-12

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How can the wealthy 'take it with them'? 6:19; Lu.12:33, 16:9, 18:22; Gal.6:8-9

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Finally, what's the last admonition to Timothy? 6:20-21; 1:11; Rom.3:1-2; IITim.1:13-14

### Paul's charge to Timothy...6:11-16

In reference to 6:9-10, what is Paul's command to Timothy? 6:11; **II Tim. 2:22**

**You flee from those things; Pursue righteousness, faith, love, perseverance, gentleness.**

What is the powerful image commanded in 6:12a? 1:18; I Cor. 9:25-26; **Eph. 6:10-18; II Tim. 4:7**

**It's to agonize in battle or athletics. Straining to fight a good fight. Like the Olympics.**

Why does Paul tell Timothy to 'take hold of eternal life'? 6:12, 19; **Col. 3:1-2; Phil. 3:20-21**

**Not to get saved! He's to take hold of the reality of eternity. Not living for the moment.**

Of what is Paul reminding Timothy by '...you were called...good confession'? 6:12b; **II Tim. 1:9**

**As all believers, he was called (salvation) by God, to which he made public confession.**

What does Paul repeat in 6:13-14a? **5:21; II Tim. 2:14, 4:1**

**He commands Timothy, before God (Father) and Christ Jesus (Son), keep these things.**

How is he to keep these commands? For how long? 6:14b; **Eph. 5:27; II Pet. 3:14**

**Keep them w/o stain or reproach (i.e. perfectly!), until the appearing of our Lord Jesus.**

When will Jesus appear? 6:15a What crescendo is added next? 6:15-16; **Rev. 1:8, 17-18**

**He will appear at the proper time! He, Sovereign, King of kings, Lord of lords. Eternal!**

### Paul's final instructions...6:17-21

What command is given to Timothy now? 6:17; **James 1:10; I Jn. 3:17**

**Instruct the wealthy not to be conceited or to trust in their riches, but on God the giver.**

What else are the wealthy instructed to do? 6:18; **Gal. 6:10; Heb. 13:16; I Pet. 3:8-12**

**Instruct them to do good, be generous (financially), be truly 'rich' in good works!**

How can the wealthy 'take it with them'? 6:19; **Lu. 12:33, 16:9, 18:22; Gal. 6:8-9**

**By generosity and good works they store up a good foundation for the future; life indeed!**

Finally, what's the last admonition to Timothy? 6:20-21; 1:11; **Rom. 3:1-2; II Tim. 1:13-14**

**Guard what's been entrusted to you! Avoid worldly chatter/'knowledge'. It leads astray.**
