The Pastoral Epistles (I, II Timothy, Titus)...

First of all, who is the (human) author of these epistles? 1:1; IITim.1:1; Titus 1:1

The Apostle, Paul. This is one of (3) 'Pastoral' epistles, written to Pastors (Tim/Titus).

What is indicated by '...my true son in the faith'? 1:1-2; ICor.4:14-17; Phil.2:19-22; Titus 1:4

Paul wrote Timothy whom he led to the Lord. They had a very close relationship.

What is the approximate timing of these (3) letters? IITim.4:6-7

ITim, Titus (~AD63), IITim (~AD67). Paul's last words to these two pastors. He's ready!

What are (2) specific goals for Paul's first epistle to Timothy? 1:18-19; 3:14-15

1. To fight the good fight 2. Instructions for conduct in God's household, the Church...

To the latter point, what church 'positions' are discussed in detail? 3:1-7, 8-10, 11

Overseer (Elder), Deacons, and their wives. Qualifications, work description, character.

Application of the Pastoral Epistles to our church...

What are our (5) Elements we recognize as guidelines/patterns for a true Christ follower?

1. Prayer 2. Devotion to the Word 3. Serving others 4. Communities 5. Make disciples.

Paul teaches each of these principles in the (3) Pastoral Epistles. For instance, what is 2:1-3?

Here Paul urges requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone!

What is the powerful truth in IITim.3:14-17? See IITim.4:1-2; 2:15; IIPet.1:19-21

The command to be devoted to the study of the Word of God. It's our true equipping!

And likewise, what does he teach in IITim.4:5? See Eph.4:11

Do the work of an evangelist, that is make disciples. The command is to seek the lost.

And what is taught in ITim.6:17-19? Rom.12:10-13; Heb.13:16; IJn.3:17

To share and serve others. This is the heart of the good deeds sought after salvation.
