

# Gospel of John

## (13.21; #50) The Glorification Begins

### John 13:21-38 ESV

After saying these things, Jesus was troubled in his spirit, and testified, "Truly, truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me." 22 The disciples looked at one another, uncertain of whom he spoke. 23 One of his disciples, whom Jesus loved, was reclining at table close to Jesus, 24 so Simon Peter motioned to him to ask Jesus of whom he was speaking. 25 So that disciple, leaning back against Jesus, said to him, "Lord, who is it?" 26 Jesus answered, "It is he to whom I will give this morsel of bread when I have dipped it." So when he had dipped the morsel, he gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot. 27 Then after he had taken the morsel, Satan entered into him. Jesus said to him, "What you are going to do, do quickly." 28 Now no one at the table knew why he said this to him. 29 Some thought that, because Judas had the moneybag, Jesus was telling him, "Buy what we need for the feast," or that he should give something to the poor. 30 So, after receiving the morsel of bread, he immediately went out. And it was night. 31 When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him. 32 If God is glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and glorify him at once. 33 Little children, yet a little while I am with you. You will seek me, and just as I said to the Jews, so now I also say to you, 'Where I am going you cannot come.' 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." 36 Simon Peter said to him, "Lord, where are you going?" Jesus answered him, "Where I am going you cannot follow me now, but you will follow afterward." 37 Peter said to him, "Lord, why can I not follow you now? I will lay down my life for you." 38 Jesus answered, "Will you lay down your life for me? Truly, truly, I say to you, the rooster will not crow till you have denied me three times."

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### **Jesus troubled in His spirit...John 13:21-38**

Why was Jesus 'troubled in His spirit'? He knew what was coming, but this...! **13:21, 6:64, 70**  
**Jesus knew 'one of you will betray me'. He knew from the beginning it was Judas. Now...**  
What was the reaction of the disciples to Jesus' declaration? **13:22-25; Mt.26:22; Mark 14:19**  
**Astonished, questioning one another. Peter persuaded John to ask Jesus who it was!**  
What do we know about Judas? Was this a spontaneous event? **13:27; Lu.21:37-22:6**  
**This betrayal was pre-planned and waiting to be carried out. It was his choice, for money!**  
Jesus gives John a sign as to the betrayer. Who does Jesus then dismiss? Why? **13:26-30**  
**The sign was Jesus giving Judas a dipped piece of bread. Then: command: Do it quickly...**  
What is significant about **13:27a? Lu.22:3-6, 14-23; 1Cor.2:1-13; Mt.27:1-10; Zech.11:7-14**  
**Judas was demon possessed in planning and executing this. But in the end, 'it was night'!**  
As soon as Judas leaves, what does Jesus declare? **13:31-32, 17:1-6, 21-24; Phil.2:11**  
**Jesus is now glorified, Father is glorified in Him, Father and Son are glorified immediately**  
What does Jesus now tell the disciples? **13:33, 36** What new command does He give? **13:34-35**  
**I am leaving but you'll follow Me later. Love one another (My example). Testimony to all.**  
What is Peter's heartfelt dialog with Jesus? **13:36-38; Mk.14:66-72; Jn .21:15-19**  
**I'll follow you regardless. I'll die for you! Jesus: before rooster crows, deny Me three times**
