

Gospel of John

(14.1; #51) The Way, The Truth, and The Life

John 14:1-17 ESV

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. 4 And you know the way to where I am going." 5

Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" 6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. 7 If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him."

8 Philip said to him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. 11 Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father. 13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

What is Jesus' first response to Thomas' question? **14:5-6a, 1:4, 17; Acts 4:12; IJn.2:21-23**

What does Jesus clearly teach next about salvation? **14:6b, 6:37, 44-45; 1:9-13; Eph.2:8-9**

What does true salvation look like? **14:7, 10:38 (ginosko, intimate, believe), 5:37 (horao)**

What is Philip's next request? **14:8,**

And Jesus' reply? **14:9, 12:45; Col.1:15; Heb.1:3; see ICor.15:12**

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Jesus' promises to the 11...John 14:1-9

Why would the Apostles have troubled hearts now? **14:1, 13:36-38; Ps.43:5**

Jesus was going to leave them! And their 'leader', Peter, was going to deny Him. What???

What are Jesus' words to comfort them (and us)? **14:1-2, 5:23, 12:44; IICor.12:7-10**

He is going to the Father's house to prepare a place (room) for you (and all believers).

And what promise does He make to them (and us)? **14:3-4; IICor.5:6-8; IThess.4:16-17**

I will come again and take you to myself, that where I am (heaven) you may be also!

What is Jesus' first response to Thomas' question? **14:5-6a, 1:4, 17; Acts 4:12; IJn.2:21-23**

I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

What does Jesus clearly teach next about salvation? **14:6b, 6:37, 44-45; 1:9-13; Eph.2:8-9**

Salvation requires coming to Jesus; that only happens by Grace, drawing by the Father.

What does true salvation look like? **14:7, 10:38 (ginosko, intimate, believe), 5:37 (horao)**

If you had known (ginosko= absolutely) Me; you would have known (eido= been aware of)

Father. From now on you do know (ginosko=absolutely) Him, and have seen(horao=form).

What is Philip's next request? **14:8,**

Lord, show (deiknuo= literally or figuratively), and it is enough (sufficient, be content).

And Jesus' reply? **14:9, 12:45; Col.1:15; Heb.1:3; see ICor.15:12**

I've been with you so long and still do not know (ginosko) Me? Show (deiknuo) Father?
