John 16:25-33 ESV

25 "I have said these things to you in figures of speech. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figures of speech but will tell you plainly about the Father. 26 In that day you will ask in my name, and I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf; 27 for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God. 28 I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father."

**I have been speaking to you in figures. The hour is coming when I will tell you plainly.**

What is Jesus saying to them in **16:26**? **14:13-14, 15:16, 16:24; Mt.7:7-11**

**When we come to Jesus with requests, Jesus does not need to ask the Father for us...**

And why is that? **16:27, 8:42, 17:7-8, 25; Eph.6:24; IPet.1:8; IJn.4:19**

**The Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me and believed I came from God!**

What about the Advocate role of Jesus? **IJn.2:1-2; Rom.8:31-39; Zech.3:1-3; Rev.12:10**

**We need an Advocate, an intercessor, to defend us when we sin. Satan always accuses us!**

What does Jesus state clearly again? **16:28, 14:28; ITim.1:15; IJn.5:11-12; Acts 1:9-11**

**I came from the Father, into the world, now I'm leaving the world and going to the Father**

And what is the response from the disciples? **16:29-30, 17:8; Mk.9:30-32; Heb.4:12-13**

**Now You're speaking clearly! Now we understand that you know our thoughts! From God**

What is Jesus' gentle rebuke? **16:31-32; Lu.9:44-45; Zech.13:7; Mt.26:47-56; 27:45-46**

**Do you now believe? Behold, you're about to leave Me alone! But the Father is with Me!**

What was Jesus' motivation for them? **16:33, 1:5, 14:27; Rom.5:1-2; IJn.5:4; IICor.13:11**

**To give them peace in Him. The world gives tribulation, but I have overcome the world!!**
