

Gospel of John

(17.1; #63) The Hour Has Come

John 17:1-5 ESV

When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, 2 since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. 4 I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. 5 And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

Overview of the next 24 hours ...Lev.16; John 17

What does Jesus mean by 'the hour has come'? 17:1, 2:4, 7:30, 8:20, 13:1, 21-31; Gal.4:4

What are some 'specific' moments soon to be known? Mk.15:25, 33-39 daylight = 12 hours

What was happening for the Jews at this same time? Lev.16:1-34, Note:16:29-34

So why is Lev.16 never going to be an exact duplicate of Jn.17? Heb.9:24-28, 10:11-18

What are some of the ways Jesus is *better* than this? Heb.2:14-3:1, 7:23-28, 8:1-13, 10:1-18

What is Jesus' first prayer? 17:1a; Phil.2:9-11 The purpose? 17:1b; 13:31-33; Mt.6:9

What has the Father first given Him? 17:2a; Phil.2:9-11; Mt.28:18; Heb.1:2, 2:8-9; IPet.3:22

And what does this authority given to Jesus specifically include? 17:2b,6,9,11-12,24; 6:37

And what is eternal life? 17:3, 3:13-18; IJn.5:11, 20; Jer.10:10

What had Jesus done to glorify the Father already? 17:4, 4:34, 5:36, 13:31-32

What is Jesus' request of the Father? 17:5, 24, 10:30, 14:9; Heb.1:3; Rev.5:9-14

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Overview of the next 24 hours ...Lev.16; John 17

What does Jesus mean by 'the hour has come'? 17:1, 2:4, 7:30, 8:20, 13:1, 21-31; Gal.4:4

The exact time, set by the Father, has arrived. Hour does not mean 60 minutes (our time).

What are some 'specific' moments soon to be known? Mk.15:25, 33-39 daylight = 12 hours
3rd hour = crucifixion; 6th hour = high noon: Jesus died at 9th hour, 3 hours after noon.

What was happening for the Jews at this same time? Lev.16:1-34, Note:16:29-34

The appointed priest was ceremonially making atonement for himself and Jewish people.

So why is Lev.16 never going to be an exact duplicate of Jn.17? Heb.9:24-28, 10:11-18

Sinful men can never duplicate the Holy Son of God. Most of Lev.16 is about priest' sin.

What are some of the ways Jesus is *better* than this? Heb.2:14-3:1, 7:23-28, 8:1-13, 10:1-18

He, perfectly sinless, came like us; eternal Priest for us; made New covenant; Once for all!

Father, the hour has come...John 17:1-5

What is Jesus' first prayer? 17:1a; Phil.2:9-11 The purpose? 17:1b; 13:31-33; Mt.6:9

Father, glorify (render glorious) Your Son (Jesus). In order that the Son may glorify You.

What has the Father first given Him? 17:2a; Phil.2:9-11; Mt.28:18; Heb.1:2, 2:8-9; IPet.3:22

The Father (having all authority) has given Jesus authority over all flesh. And all creation.

And what does this authority given to Jesus specifically include? 17:2b,6,9,11-12,24; 6:37

He has authority to give eternal life to all those whom the Father has given Him. Chosen.

And what is eternal life? 17:3, 3:13-18; IJn.5:11, 20; Jer.10:10

It is to know the Father, the only true God, and Jesus Christ (the Son) sent by the Father.

What had Jesus done to glorify the Father already? 17:4, 4:34, 5:36, 13:31-32

He glorified the Father on earth by accomplishing the work the Father gave Him to do.

What is Jesus' request of the Father? 17:5, 24, 10:30, 14:9; Heb.1:3; Rev.5:9-14

Glorify Me in Your presence (heaven) with the glory I had before the world existed!
