(17.20; #66) Prayer For Those Who Will Believe

John 17:20-26 ESV

20 "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, 21 that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. 22 The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, 23 I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me. 24 Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world. 25 O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me. 26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them."

And what will be the result for future believers? 17:26b, 23, 14:20; Gal.2:20; Col.1:24-27

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Not for these only... John 17:20-26

Who, specifically, does Jesus now include in His prayer? 17:20; Rom.10:17; Acts 13:48

He prays for those who (will) believe in (have faith in) Him through their Word.

What is the purpose He states for their believing? 17:21a; Acts 4:1-4; Eph.4:1-7; Gal.3:28

That they may all be one, just as (same manner as) you Father, are in Me and I in You...

What does the 'oneness' look like? 17:21b, 23, 13:35; Eph.4:3, 13; Col.3:14 Present or future?

All believers would be perfected in unity. Sometimes sin gets in the way now. In eternity!

What has Jesus done for all believers? 17:22, 11, 14:20; 1Jn.1:3, 3:23-24

I gave (gives) My glory (given to Him by the Father) that they may be one, like We are!

What is one purpose of this unity for believers? 17:23, 13:35; 1Jn.1:3; Eph.4:12-13

So that the world may know that You sent Me and loved them even as You loved Me!

What else does Jesus pray for all believers? 17:24, 5, 14:1-3; 1Thess.4:13-18; 1Cor.13:12

All those whom the Father has given Me, may be with Me to see My glory, You gave Me...

What is Jesus' declaration re knowing the Father? 17:25; Rom.3:26; Mt.11:27; Jn.17:8

The world doesn't know You but I know You and these know that You have sent Me.

What does Jesus declare about making the Father known? 17:26a, 6, 14:23

Jesus made the Father's name known to them (disciples) and will continue (all believers).

And what will be the result for future believers? 17:26b, 23, 14:20; Gal.2:20; Col.1:24-27

This is so that the Father's love for Jesus may be in them, and I in them! AMEN!!
