(19.16; #73) Behold God's Lamb

John 19:16-27 ESV

16 So he delivered him over to them to be crucified. So they took Jesus, 17 and he went out, bearing his own cross, to the place called the place of a skull, which in Aramaic is called Golgotha. 18 There they crucified him, and with him two others, one on either side, and Jesus between them. 19 Pilate also wrote an inscription and put it on the cross. It read, "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews." 20 Many of the Jews read this inscription, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city, and it was written in Aramaic, in Latin, and in Greek. 21 So the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews,' but rather, 'This man said, I am King of the Jews.'" 22 Pilate answered, "What I have written I have written."

23 When the soldiers had crucified Jesus, they took his garments and divided them into four parts, one part for each soldier; also his tunic. But the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom, 24 so they said to one another, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it to see whose it shall be." What did the soldiers require of Jesus after Pilate's judgment? [19:17](#) also sign confessing guilt

The victims were required to carry their own cross. The cross is usually about 200 pounds.

But what happens? [Mt.27:32; Mk.15:21; Lu.23:26](#) see [Rom.16:13](#) (humiliation, but salvation)

Severely weakened by scourging, He is unable to carry the cross. Simon forced to carry it.

So Jesus forced to the front, driven by 4 or more soldiers, then Simon, then whom? [Lu.23:26-27](#)

There was a great multitude following of people, and specifically women, mourning...

What warning does Jesus give to these women? [Lu.23:28-31, 21:23-24; Rev.6:16; Mt.27:25](#)

Weep for yourselves and your children! Time comes when barren are blessed. Green/dry!!

What happens next? [Lu.23:32-33; Jn.19:17-18; Mt.27:33-35; Mk.15:22-24](#)

Arriving at Golgotha they crucified Jesus and two others, criminals. Excruciating process.

What final 'jab' at the Jews does Pilate make? [Jn.19:19-22; Mt.27:37; Mk.15:26; Lu.23:38](#)

The official 'crime' of Jesus is 'This is the King of the Jews', vs demand of Jewish leaders.

What does Luke record of Jesus' repeated words during crucifying? [Lu.23:33-34; Is.53:12](#)

'Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.' Jesus intercedes for the soldiers!

What Scripture is fulfilled next? [Mt.27:35; Mk.15:24; Lu.23:34b; Jn.19:23-24; Ps.22:11-18](#)

On the cross, no strength left, they stare, and divide my garments and cast lots for them.
