

Gospel of John

(19:25; #74) Jesus on the Cross

John 19:25-32 **ESV**

25 but standing by the cross of Jesus were his mother and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!" 27 Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home. 28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst." 29 A jar full of sour wine stood there, so they put a sponge full of the sour wine on a hyssop branch and held it to his mouth. 30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "It is finished," and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. 31 Since it was the day of Preparation, and so that the bodies would not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken and that they might be taken away. 32 So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with him.

All mocking Him! Passers by, chief priests, scribes, elders, thieves, soldiers. Comment?

Of all the mocking unbelievers there, who singularly stands out? [Lu.23:39-43](#); [Eph.2:8-10](#)

One of the thieves had faith given to him. Against all odds, he asked Jesus for help!

At great personal danger, who is identified at the cross? [Mt.27:55-56](#); [Mk.15:40-41](#); [Jn.19:25](#)

Mary, Jesus' mother; her sister, Salome (James/John); Mary (Clopas); Mary Magdalene.

What emotional event takes place re Jesus, Mary and John? [Jn.19:26-27](#); [Lu.2:35](#)

Jesus commits the care / support of Mary (as her firstborn) to John, His beloved disciple.

What happens at noon? [Mt.27:45](#); [Mk.15:33](#); [Lu.23:44-45](#); [II Cor.5:21](#); [Ex.10:21-22](#); [Ps.22:6-8](#)

Total darkness over the land for 3 hours. Father turns away. Jesus is bearing our sins...

What happens at 3pm? [Mt.27:45-46](#); [Mk.15:33-34](#)

After 3 hours He calls out (loud voice!), 'My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?'

What happens after this? [Mt.27:47-49](#); [Mk.15:35-36](#); [Jn.19:28-29](#); [Ps.22:15](#), [69:21](#)

Jesus, to fulfill Scripture said 'I thirst'. Tormenting reply, sour wine (vinegar) on a sponge.

What are the astounding Words of Jesus next? [Jn.19:30](#), [4:34](#); [Dan.9:24](#), [26](#); [Is.53:1-12](#)

Jesus said, 'It is finished'! (telestai, paid in full). All our transgressions paid for in full!

And what are Jesus' final words from the cross? [Mt.27:50-51](#); [Mk.15:37-38](#); [Lu.23:45-46](#)

With a loud voice 'Father, into Your hands I commit My Spirit'. He dismissed His Spirit!
