(2) Everything Made by Him

John 1:1-5

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

And the Word was God...Jn. 1:1c-1:2

What *fundamental* truth does John re-emphasize about the Word? [Jn.1:1c](#); [Is.9:6](#); [Phil.2:6](#)

What other truth is demonstrated from Jn.1:1? [10:30](#); [Phil.2:5-11](#); [17:11](#), [20-23](#); [1Jn.3:1-3](#)

List *some* attributes of God. [1Pet.1:13-16](#); [Ps.90:2](#), [139:8](#); [Mt.19:26](#); [Rom.16:27](#); [Is.40:28](#)

These are all attributes of the Word. But what does the Word do? [Jn.1:14](#); [Phil.2:1-11](#); [Heb.5:8](#)

What is re-emphasized in Jn.1:2? [1:1c](#)

All things were made through Him..Jn.1:3

What is the crystal clear declaration of Jn.1:3? [Col.1:16](#); [Heb.1:12](#), [11:3](#); [Rev.4:11](#), [10:6](#)

And what is *one heresy* absolutely refuted by this truth?

When Jesus created everything, what was it like? [Gen.1:31](#); [Heb.13:8](#)

But what happened to that *perfect creation*? [Gen.3:1-24](#); [Rom.5:12](#)

And what is the cure for this curse? [Rom.8:18-25](#); [Isa.11:6-9](#), [65:25](#)

And ultimately what will happen? [Heb.1:10-12](#); [1Pet.3:8-13](#); [Rev.21:1-8](#); [1Cor.15:20-28](#)

Application:

How does Jn.1:1-3 impact the Gospel? You? Is it important to you?

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John 1:1-5

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And the Word was God...Jn. 1:1c-1:2

What *fundamental* truth does John re-emphasize about the Word? **Jn.1:1c; Is.9:6; Phil.2:6**

He says 'the Word was God'. Co-equal, face-to-face, from eternity past, ...God!

What other truth is demonstrated from Jn.1:1? **10:30; Phil.2:5-11; 17:11, 20-23; Jn.3:1-3**

The Word and God are co-equal but distinct. They are face-to-face! Separate, but one!

List *some* attributes of God. **IPet.1:13-16; Ps.90:2, 139:8; Mt.19:26; Rom.16:27; Is.40:28**

Holiness, Eternal, Omnipresent, Omnipotent, Omniscient, Incomprehensibility, etc .

These are all attributes of the Word. But what does the Word do? **Jn.1:14; Phil.2:1-11; Heb.5:8**

The Word became flesh. He willingly 'un-grasped' some attributes of Deity. Death...

What is re-emphasized in Jn.1:2? **1:1c**

The Word was (continuing to exist) in the beginning with (face-to-face) God (Father).

All things were made through Him..Jn.1:3

What is the crystal clear declaration of Jn.1:3? **Col.1:16; Heb.1:12, 11:3; Rev.4:11, 10:6**

He, the Word, the Lord Jesus Christ, created everything! Nothing not created by Him!

And what is *one heresy* absolutely refuted by this truth?

The heresy that Jesus is 'a god', a created being. The total Scriptures are clear on this.

When Jesus created everything, what was it like? **Gen.1:31; Heb.13:8**

When God (The Word) surveyed His literal six-day creation, behold it was very good.

But what happened to that *perfect creation*? **Gen.3:1-24; Rom.5:12**

Sin entered into this perfection...and God cursed serpent, Eve, Adam, all creation...

And what is the cure for this curse? **Rom.8:18-25; Isa.11:6-9, 65:25**

All creation (and us) groans under curse, waiting for the redemption of our bodies!

And ultimately what will happen? **Heb.1:10-12; IPet.3:8-13; Rev.21:1-8; ICor.15:20-28**

This present creation will be un-created and behold, He makes all things new...forever.
