(5.30) Three Witnesses for Jesus

John 5:30-47 ESV

...32 There is another who bears witness about me, and I know that the testimony that he bears about me is true. 33 You sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. 34 Not that the testimony that I receive is from man, but I say these things so that you may be saved. 35 He was a burning and shining lamp, and you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light. 36 But the testimony that I have is greater than that of John. For the works that the Father has given me to accomplish, the very works that I am doing, bear witness about me that the Father has sent me. 37 And the Father who sent me has himself borne witness about me. His voice you have never heard, his form you have never seen, 38 and you do not have his word abiding in you, for you do not believe the one whom he has sent. 39 You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, 40 yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.

...44 How can you believe, when you receive glory from one another and do not seek the glory that comes from the only God? 45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope. 46 If you believed Moses, you would believe me; for he wrote of me. 47 But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe my words?"

What is Jesus saying about Himself in 5:30-31? **Deut:17:6; Jn.8:13-14, 8:54**

So, who does Jesus call as His first witness? **5:32-33, 1:29-34,**

What does Jesus make clear re John's testimony? **5:34, 39-41, 20:31**

What does Jesus point to as being a *greater testimony* than John's? **5:35-36, 10:25, 14:10-11**

What was it about His works that was *critically* important? **5:36, 20:30-31, 3:2, 14:10**

In addition to John, the works of the Father, what else does Jesus point to? **5:37-40; Lu.24:44**

What does Jesus encourage them to do? **5:39; Lu.16:29-31; Rom.10:17**

But what was the result for these Jews? **5:40, 1:11; Is.53:1-3; Jn.12:37-41**

What does this demonstrate about Spiritual truths? **ICor.1:18, 22-25; Acts 28:24-27; Heb.4:7**

What does Jesus point out to them? **5:44-47, 7:37-38; Rom.10:17; IITim.3:16**

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The Witnesses for Jesus.. Jn.5.30-47

What is Jesus saying about Himself in 5:30-31? **Deut:17:6; Jn.8:13-14, 8:54**

The Levitical law states self witness is inadequate (legally). Require 2 or more witnesses.

So, who does Jesus call as His first witness? **5:32-33, 1:29-34,**

He calls John the Baptizer who's bourn witness to the Truth. He testified often / Jesus!

What does Jesus make clear re John's testimony? **5:34, 39-41, 20:31**

I'm not dependent on any man's testimony but I mention him so that you would believe.

What does Jesus point to as being a *greater testimony* than Johns? **5:35-36, 10:25, 14:10-11**

John's testimony was great but the works the Father gave me to do, are much greater!

What was it about His works that was *critically* important? **5:36, 20:30-31, 3:2, 14:10**

They proved that the Father (God) has sent Him (Jesus), makes Father His Witness!

In addition to John, the works of the Father, what else does Jesus point to? **5:37-40; Lu.24:44**

The Father has given you the Scriptures, witnessing about Me, yet you refuse Me!

What does Jesus encourage them to do? **5:39; Lu.16:29-31; Rom.10:17**

Search the Scriptures, because they testify of Me. They testify of eternal life in Me!

But what was the result for these Jews? **5:40, 1:11; Is.53:1-3; Jn.12:37-41**

These Jews, knowing the Scriptures, refused to come to Jesus for salvation. Blinded...

What does this demonstrate about Spiritual truths? **ICor.1:18, 22-25; Acts 28:24-27; Heb.4:7**

Today, this moment in time, do not reject His offer of Salvation. Results may be...?

What does Jesus point out to them? **5:44-47, 7:37-38; Rom.10:17; IITim.3:16**

You trust in Moses, not God. Moses wrote of Me. Don't believe him, won't believe Me!
