(6.35) All The Father Gives Me

John 6:35-46 ESV

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst. 36 But I said to you that you have seen me and yet do not believe. 37 All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out. 38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me. 39 And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. 40 For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."

41 So the Jews grumbled about him, because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven." 42 They said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" 43 Jesus answered them, "Do not grumble among yourselves. 44 No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day. 45 It is written in the Prophets, 'And they will all be taught by God.' Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me— 46 not that anyone has seen the Father except he who is from God; he has seen the Father.

What is Jesus' response to their grumbling? **6:43-44; ICor.10:10; Jude 16:14-16**

How does the Father 'draw' one to Christ? **6:45-46; 65; Eph.1:17, 4:21-22**

So why is it so important to read and study the Word of God? 6:45-46; **Rom.10:14-17**

And how does Paul teach these truths from Jesus? **Eph.2:8-10; IITim.2:25**

Gospel of John

(6.35) All The Father Gives Me

John 6:35-46 ESV

Coming to Christ.. Jn.6:35-46

What kind of bread does Jesus ascribe to Himself? **6:35, 41, 48-58; ICor.11:23-29**

He is the spiritual bread of life (eternal). Physical bread is simply an analogy for Him.

How does Jesus describe this crowd? **6:36, 64; 12:37; 15:24-25; IPet.1:8-9**

As those who have seen Him (and all His signs/miracles) yet still do not believe in Him.

What amazing truth does He reveal to them? **6:37,39,45; 17:6-11; 6:44,65; IIThess.2:13-14**

All that the Father gives Me will come to Me; whoever comes to Me I will never cast out

So how might we describe 'whoever comes to me'? **6:37, 44**

They are a 'love gift' from the Father to the Son. The Father draws them to the Son!

What does Jesus emphasize to them, again? **6:38, 3:13, 31; Mt.26:39-42**

I have come down from heaven not to do my will, but the will of Him who sent Me...

And what is the will of Him (Father) who sent Me (son)? **6:39-40; Rom.8:28-31; Jn.11:25**

That I (Jesus) should lose nothing of all He has given Me; raise them up to eternal life.

So what was the general reaction to Jesus' teaching here? **6:41-42, 7:12; Lu.5:30, 19:7**

Grumbled, challenged His claims. 'We know His father and mother'. From heaven...?

What is Jesus' response to their grumbling? **6:43-44; ICor.10:10; Jude 16:14-16**

Stop grumbling! No one can come to me unless the Father, who sent Me, draws him!

How does the Father 'draw' one to Christ? **6:45-46; 65; Eph.1:17, 4:21-22**

As written, 'they will be taught by God'. Everyone who heard/learned comes to me!

So why is it so important to read and study the Word of God? **6:45-46; Rom.10:14-17**

Saving faith comes by hearing the Word of Christ. Even the OT saints heard of Christ.

And how does Paul teach these truths from Jesus? **Eph.2:8-10; IITim.2:25**

By grace (unmerited favor) you're saved by faith and that (faith) is not of you. A gift...
