

An Overview of Biblical Prophecy

(9) The Gentiles

The focus shifts to the Gentiles...Rom. 11

What happened when Israel (nation) rejected the Gospel? Acts 28:23-31; Rom.11:11

God takes the Gospel directly to the Gentiles. Note it is to make the Jews jealous!

As a reminder, what is still true about the Jews? Rom.11:1-6

There is still a remnant, chosen by God's grace who are saved. Paul was one of them...

And what about the rest of the Jews who knowingly reject God's Gospel? Rom.11:7-10

God rejects them! He gives them eyes that don't see, ears that don't hear, spirit of stupor!

Is this situation unique to the Jews? Rom.1:18-32 (note vs. 24, 26, 28)

No. After one rejects God, He may then reject them. He gives them over to their sin.

What is one of the societal steps in this 'giving over'? Rom.11:26-27

He relaxes the restraint on sexual sins. Result is homosexuality. It IS the judgment.

And since our nation is arrogantly rushing to this sin, what can we expect next? vs.28-32

Depraved minds (worthless), doing things not proper (vs.29-32). Worse and worse.

How does Paul describe this state to the church at Corinth? IICor.4:3-4

Satan has blinded the eyes (spiritually) of the lost. They can't see the light of the Gospel!

So in your own words what is God's judgment on those who knowingly reject the Gospel?

But! Just like the Jewish remnant, what's true of the Gentiles as well? IICor.6:9-11

And such were some of you! But you were washed, sanctified, justified in the Lord Jesus...

As a reminder, what's true today about a saved Jew and/or a saved Gentile? Eph.2:14-22

We're both united in Christ. No 'wall' between us. One Spirit, One Father, One Lord.

The Gentiles in the Tribulation...Rev.4-19

What happens to a great multitude of Gentiles in the great tribulation? Rev.7:9-17

They are martyred for their faith in Christ. A great multitude that no one could count.

What happens to other Gentiles in the tribulation? Rev.13:1-7, vs.8

They are deceived into worshiping 'the beast', the antichrist. Only redeemed will not...

What's the fate of those who worship the beast? Rev.16:13-16; 19:11-19; 20, 21; Zech.14:12

They are totally destroyed at the battle of Armageddon by the Lord Jesus Christ.

Are there any Gentiles who survive the tribulation? Is.13:6-13, note vs.12; Zech.14:16

Yes, a few from every nation. All saved. They enter Millennial Kingdom w/saved Israel.

What then is the state of every Jew/Gentile entering the Millennial Kingdom? Mt.25:31-46

All Christ rejecters have been removed. Only saved (or innocent children?) enter.
