

Prophecy Overview

(9) The Resurrection Prophecy Fulfilled

Luke 24:13-27

13 Now that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. 14 They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. 15 As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; 16 but they were kept from recognizing him. 17 He asked them, "What are you discussing together as you walk along?" They stood still, their faces downcast. 18 One of them, named Cleopas, asked him, "Are you only a visitor to Jerusalem and do not know the things that have happened there in these days?" 19 "What things?" he asked. "About Jesus of Nazareth," they replied. "He was a prophet, powerful in word and deed before God and all the people. 20 The chief priests and our rulers handed him over to be sentenced to death, and they crucified him; 21 but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel. And what is more, it is the third day since all this took place. 22 In addition, some of our women amazed us. They went to the tomb early this morning 23 but didn't find his body. They came and told us that they had seen a vision of angels, who said he was alive. 24 Then some of our companions went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said, but him they did not see." 25 He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Did not the Christ have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" 27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself. The Resurrection of Christ, Son of God...Rev.1

Describe the appearance of the resurrected Christ as John sees Him. Rev.1:12-16

What is John's immediate reaction? 1:17a (Jn.21:20-24) And the Words of Christ? 1:17b

And how does He confirm the Resurrection to John? 1:18

How important is the Resurrection? ICor.15:3-4, 12-19, 20-23

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The Resurrection of Christ, Son of Man...Lu.24:13-27

What was the general state of the disciples after the Crucifixion? Lu.24:13:14, 17-24

They were discouraged, disillusioned, confused, searching for answers. Was He Messiah?

Comment on the discussion in 24:17-19a.

Jesus is gentle with them, even extending humor (vs.19a)! His glory is hidden from them.

How does this encounter reflect the 'grace in which we stand'? Rom.5:2, 8:1; Heb.4:16, 13:5-6

For those who are 'in Christ...', there is no condemnation! He is always working for us!

At this point, what was the primary thing these disciples were lacking? 24:25

They lacked completed faith in Christ. They thought He had been defeated by death.

And what is always the remedy for lack of faith? Rom.10:17 What does Jesus do? 24:25-27

He taught them from the Scriptures about Himself. What passages do you think He used?

At the time they were written, what were those Scriptures? 24:25; Is.53; Ps.22; Zech.9:9; etc.

They were written by prophets. They were prophetic. History written before it happens!

As the resurrected Son of Man, what is His relationship to us believers? Jn.20:17

He names us '...brothers'. He's returning to My Father/your Father, My God/your God.

How does that really impact you today??

The Resurrection of Christ, Son of God...Rev.1

Describe the appearance of the resurrected Christ as John sees Him. Rev.1:12-16

He sees Christ, the Son of God, High Priest. He's Judge, Head of the Church, Deity/Glory!

What is John's immediate reaction? 1:17a (Jn.21:20-24) And the Words of Christ? 1:17b

John fell at His feet as dead! But Christ touched him and said 'Do not be afraid...!'

And how does He confirm the Resurrection to John? 1:18

I am the Living One! I was dead and behold I am alive for ever and ever! All authority!

How important is the Resurrection? ICor.15:3-4, 12-19, 20-23

It is absolutely critical! But Christ is Risen! And believers are now justified, Rom.5:25!!
