### The witness of God's Holy Words ...Ps.19:7-11

What's a 'limitation' regarding the witness of God's creation (1:6)? Gen.3:17-19; Rom.8:20-22

**Creation now bears God's curse because of our sin. The glory of creation is 'marred'.**

How is this experienced?

**Earthquakes, floods, tornadoes, droughts, tsunamis, etc. Death in nature, 'acts of god'.**

While absolutely *enough*, what does God graciously *add to creation* to reveal Him? IIPet.25

**He added Prophets, preachers of righteousness (like Noah). They declared God's Words.**

And additionally, what does God graciously add to Prophets/Preachers? Ps.19:7

**The Law of the Lord. He adds the written Word of God and it is perfect! Not 'marred'.**

To the Jew, what is the special meaning of 'Law of the Lord'? Rom.5:12

**This phrase is usually representing the Torah, referring to the specific Levitical laws.**

From 19:7-9, what are the (6) *items* that are "...of the Lord"? 19:7-9 Comment?

**The Law, statutes, precepts, commands, fear and ordinances. Facets of God's Words.**

And what are the (6) *descriptors/definers* for each '...of the Lord'? 19:7-9

**Perfect, trustworthy, right, radiant, pure, sure and altogether righteous! Not marred!**

What are the (6) *benefits* for each '...of the Lord'? 19:7-10 (Note: no updates, Rev.22:18-19!)

**Revive/soul, make wise, gives joy, gives light, endures forever, more precious than Gold!**

What are the (4) conclusions given by the Psalmist about the (6) '...of the Lord'? 19:10-11

**They're more precious than gold, sweeter than honey, warn us, keep them = great reward.**

2 Tim 3:16-17

16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; 17 so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work. NASU

What further clarity about '...of the Lord', 'inspired by God' does Paul give? IITim.3:16

**All Scripture is profitable for teaching, reproof, correction, training in righteousness.**

What is absolutely clear, yet incredibly ignored today? IITim.3:17

**All SCRIPTURE totally, completely, equips a believer for EVERY good work! Complete!!**
