Terms for the unredeemed	Terms for the redeemed
in the flesh, 7:5; old self, Eph.4:22	<i>in</i> the Spirit, 8:9; not <i>in</i> the flesh, 7:5, 8:8
in Adam, ICor.15:22	in Christ, 8:1
sinful passions, aroused by the Law, at work in the members of our body, bearing fruit for death, 7:5	released from the Law, having died to that by which we were bound, 7:6
in oldness of the letter, 7:6	we serve in newness of the Spirit, 7:6
sin, through the commandment, produced coveting of every kind, 7:8	<i>of</i> the flesh (not <i>in</i> the flesh), sold into bondage to sin, 7:14
when the commandment came, sin came alive, and I died. 7:9	not practicing what I would like to do, but doing the things I hate, 7:15
supposed life giving commandment brought death, 7:10	agree with the Law, that it is good. 7:16
sin, through the commandment, deceived me, and killed me. 7:11	It is no longer I sinning, but sin living in me that does it. 7:20
the commandment made sin utterly sinful, 7:13	PRINCIPLE: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me, 7:21
walk according to the flesh, set their mind on the things of the flesh, 8:5	in the inner man, I joyfully delight in God's law, 7:22; IICor.4:16; Eph.3:16
the mind set on the flesh is hostile to God, not subject to the Law of God, is not even able to do so, 8:7	another law in the members of my body, waging war against my mind, making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work in my members, 7:23
those in the flesh cannot please God, 8:8	wretched man that I am! 7:24
	Who will save me from this body of death? 7:24
	I myself, in my mind I serve God's law 7:25
	but, with the flesh, I serve the law of sin.
	NO CONDEMNATION to those in Christ Jesus, 8:1
	not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, 8:9
	walk according to the Spirit, 8:4
	indwelt by the Spirit, 8:9
	body is dead (because of sin) but the spirit is alive because of righteousness, 8:10
	life (eternal) is coming for our mortal bodies, through the Spirit who lives in us. 8:11
