### *A closer look at our spiritual gifts...Rom.12:4-8*

Why has the Lord given spiritual gifts to all true believers? Jn.15:5; ICor.12:25

**1. Apart from Life in Christ, we can do nothing (to please Him) 2. Minister to one another**

What is the command of Jn.15:5? What is the implication?

**We are commanded to abide in Him. Implied is that a believer may choose not to obey.**

What are the consequences for "service" that's not by His Spirit? ICor.3:10-15

**Wood, hay, and straw, burned up at the Judgment of believer's works (Bema judgment)**

What truth is Paul very careful and very explicitly guarding in this judgment passage? ICor.3:15

**Believers with wood, hay, and straw will suffer loss, but will be saved. Smell of smoke...**

What is *prophecy* (Gr.-prophetia)? ICor.14:3; IPet.4:11

**It is the gift of 'speaking forth' the Word of God. Edification; sometimes future-predicting.**

What is *service* (Gr.-diakonia)? Acts 6:3-4

**One who serves, table waiter. Deacon, deaconess. Broad term for every sort of help.**

What is *teaching* (Gr.-didaskon)? IITim.1:11; 2:2; Eph.4:11; Titus1:7-9

**Refers to the act of teaching or what is taught. It is regular, systematic, interpretation.**

What is exhortation (Gr.-parakaleo, paraklesis)? cp Jn.14:16;

**Called alongside to help. Closely tied to parakletos for Holy Spirit as advocate, comforter.**

What is *contributing* (Gr.-metadidomi)? IThess.2:8; Eph.4:28

**Intensified (meta) giving. Sharing that which is one's own. All have some responsibility.**

How is this contributing to be done? vs.8; IICor.9:6-7

**Do it liberally, generously, with joy. God will supply all your needs.**

What is leadership (Gr.-proistemi)? IThess.5:12

**'Standing before', a leader. It is to be done with great diligence, carefulness.**

What is mercy (Gr.-eleeo)? Mt.5:7

**Special sensitivity to the needs of others, and meeting them, cheerfully. Greatly needed...**
