(14) The Tabernacle Covering

Ex 26:1 "Moreover, you shall make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twined linen and blue and purple and scarlet yarns; you shall make them with cherubim skillfully worked into them. ...

Ex 26:7 "You shall also make curtains of goats' hair for a tent over the tabernacle; eleven curtains shall you make. ...

Ex 26:14 And you shall make for the tent a covering of tanned rams' skins and a covering of goatskins on top.

Rev 4:6-8

And around the throne, on each side of the throne, are four living creatures, full of eyes in front and behind: 7 the first living creature like a lion, the second living creature like an ox, the third living creature with the face of a man, and the fourth living creature like an eagle in flight. 8 And the four living creatures, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within ... *ESV*

What are the (4) *faces* of the (4) living beings around God's throne? **Rev.4:6-7**

How do the (4) *Gospels* correspond to this image?

What are the (4) *specific colors* used in the Tabernacle? **Ex.26:1, 31-36; 27:16; 28:6, 15**

What do these (4) colors signify about Christ? (Cp. Rev.4:6-7)

Considering the (4) Roof Coverings of the Tabernacle...Ex.26:1-14

What is the first (inner) roof covering? **Ex.26:1** Per above, what is signified about Christ?

So what did the Levitical priest see from *inside the tabernacle*? Note: **Truly In Christ!**

What was placed over this linen covering? **Ex.26:7** What's the significance? **Lev.16:7-10**

What was placed over the linen and goats hair? **Ex.26:14a** Significance? **Heb.10:19-22**

And what is the last covering? **Ex.26:14b** Significance? **Is.53:1-3**

Starting from the outside going in, what is the sequence of Christ's attributes? **Salvation!!**

Halleluiah! What a Savior!!

Considering (4) Aspects Describing Christ...Rev.4:6-11

What are the (4) faces of the (4) living beings around God's throne? **Rev.4:6-7**

1. Lion (King) 2. Ox (Servant/Sacrifice) 3. Man (Humanity) 4. Eagle (Divinity).

How do the (4) Gospels correspond to this image?

1. Matthew-King 2. Mark-Servant 3. Luke-Perfect Humanity 4. John-Divinity

What are the (4) specific colors used in the Tabernacle? **Ex.26:1, 31-36; 27:16; 28:6, 15**

Blue, purple, scarlet, white (linen). Used in roof, veil/screen, one gate, ephod/breastplate

What do these (4) colors signify about Christ? (Cp. Rev.4:6-7)

1. Purple-King 2. Scarlet-Servant/Sacrifice 3. White-Humanity 4. Blue-Heaven/Deity

Considering the (4) Roof Coverings of the Tabernacle...Ex.26:1-14

What is the first (inner) roof covering? **Ex.26:1** Per above, what is signified about Christ?

Fine twined linen w/blue/purple/scarlet Cherubim. -King, Sacrifice, Purity, Divinity.

So what did the Levitical priest see from *inside the tabernacle*? Note: **Truly In Christ!**

Entrance curtain, Veil, ceiling; linen w/cherubim. Walls/candlestick, table, altar; gold!

What was placed over this linen covering? **Ex.26:7** What's the significance? **Lev.16:7-10**

A curtain of goat's hair. -Reminder of sacrificial goat and scapegoat. Price/removal!

What was placed over the linen and goats hair? **Ex.26:14a** Significance? **Heb.10:19-22**

Ram's skins tanned (dyed red). Red-blood. Points to sacrificial blood of Christ for us.

And what is the last covering? **Ex.26:14b** Significance? **Is.53:1-3**

A covering of goatskins (or badger/porpoise). Plain/unattractive; all the 'world' sees!

Starting from the outside going in, what is the sequence of Christ's attributes? **Salvation!!**

Ordinary human-> shed blood sacrifice-> sin paid and removed forever-> in Christ!

Halleluiah! What a Savior!!
