Being rooted and grounded in love

What was realized according to the Father's eternal purpose? 3:9-11

His eternal purpose was realized in Christ Jesus our Lord. This is the Mystery! Hidden!! What are 2 things we have in Christ Jesus? 3:12a, 2:18; Rom.5:2; Heb.4:15-16, 10:19-22 We have boldness (confidence) and access (into this grace in which we stand!) And how do we obtain these 2 things? 3:12b; Heb.4:16; Mt.27:45-54; Lev.16:1-2 We have boldness and access to the throne of grace by our faith in Him (Christ Jesus)! So, because of this gift of access to the throne of grace, what did he want? 3:13; IICor.4:16 He wants them not to lose heart (faint) by his sufferings for them! It's your blessing! Paul's prayer for them: For this reason (suffering for them), what does he do? 3:14; Rom.1:16 Paul, chained to Roman guards, bowed his knees before the Father. Not ashamed...! What does Paul mean in vs.15? Universal fatherhood?? 3:15; Lu.3:38; Jn.1:11-13; IJn.3:1-2 All have the fatherhood of God by creation. But only believers have Him by new new birth What is now Paul's first prayer (of 4) for them? 3:16; Rom.7:22; IICor.4:16 He may grant you to be strengthened w/power, through His Spirit, in *your inner being*! What is the glaring difference of this prayer and most of our prayers? 3:16b; Phil.2:25-30 Most of our prayers are for the 'outer being'. That's not wrong, but it is not #1! Change!! How had Paul learned this first hand? **IICor.12:7-10** Paul's thorn in the flesh was in the outer being. But he wanted strength/inner being more!

How do we see the results of His power in our inner being? Phil.4:13; IICor.4:16; Zech.10:12 We don't lose heart with our outer being wasting away! Inner being is renewed daily!!
