And what does 'into Christ...' produce? 4:16; ICor.12:12-31; Col.2:19; ICor.13:4-9, 13

He gave gifted men: The apostles, prophets, evangelists, shepherds (pastors), teachers...

And what was their purpose / function? 4:12; IITim.3:16-17; Acts 9:31, 20:32; Heb.13:17

To equip the saints for the work of ministry, to build up the body of Christ (Church).

What's the first listed goal of 'building up the body of Christ'? 4:13; Jn.17:20-23; ICor.1:10

That we all (believers) attain (come to) unity in the faith. By this...unbelievers will know...

What's next on the list? 4:13; Jn.17:3, 17:25-26; IICor.4:6; Phil.3:8; Col.2:2; IIPet.3:18; IJn.5:20

To come to a full, thorough, knowledge of the Son of God. To mature manhood (grown up)
And all of this is 'so that...'? 4:14; ICor.3:1-2, 14:20; Heb.5:12-14; Acts 20:30-31; IJn.4:1

So that we may *no longer be children* (spiritual infants). Tossed by every cunning doctrine. Rather, how are we to be? 4:15; Ps.32:2; Jn.1:47; Rom.12:9; James 2:15-16; IPet.1:22

We are to speak the truth in love, and grow up in every way, into the head, into Christ...!

And what does 'into Christ...' produce? 4:16; ICor.12:12-31; Col.2:19; ICor.13:4-9, 13

The whole body, held together by every joint, when working properly, grows body via love!
