Bitterness, wrath (savage), anger (4:26), clamor (shouting, brawling), slander, malice (evil) What are some things we must *add*? 4:32 ; Rom.12:10; ICor.13:4; Col.3:12-13; Mt.18:21-35

Be kind, forgiving, tenderhearted to one another, as God in Christ forgave you!

What is our example in this living? 5:1-2 ; Mt.5:45, 48; IPet.1:15-16; IJn.4:11

Be imitators of God and walk in love as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us! What is specifically prohibited for believers? 5:3 ; Rom.6:13; ICor.5:11, 6:9-20

Sexual immorality and all impurity or coveteousness. Not even named among you! What is associated with this impure behavior? 5:4, 19-20; 1:16; Ps.33:1, 92:1, 107:21-22

<u>Filthiness (obscenity), foolish talk (dull, stupid), crude joking; rather let it be thanksgiving</u> What is the sober warning of 5:5? ICor.6:9-10; Gal.5:19-21; Rev.21:8

Everyone who is sexually immoral/impure/covetous has no inheritance in kingdom of God. And be further warned about what? 5:6; Jer.21:8-9; Mt.24:4, 24; Col.2:8; IJn.4:1

Being deceived by empty words, because of these things the wrath of God comes...!
