

### Eph.5:21-33 ESV (emphasis added)

- <sup>21</sup> submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.
- <sup>22</sup> Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.
- <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.
- <sup>24</sup> Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.
- <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her,
- <sup>26</sup> that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,
- <sup>27</sup> so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.
- <sup>28</sup> In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.
- <sup>29</sup> For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church,
- <sup>30</sup> because we are members of his body.
- <sup>31</sup> "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh."
- <sup>32</sup> This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church.
- <sup>33</sup> However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

Examples: ICor.15:27-28; Heb.2:8; Lu.2:41-51,10:17, 20; Rom.13:1-7; Titus 3:1; James 4:6-10

How should we give thanks/submit? 5:20-21; Ps.34:1; Phil.4:6; Col.3:17; Rom.13:1-5; IPet.2:17

Thanks always, for everything to Father in Jesus' Name. Submit to others w/reverence...
What does "submit" mean? Heb.13:17

Submit = "hupeiko", to yield / submit. As those who watch over your souls. Like to Christ! Examples: ICor.15:27-28; Heb.2:8; Lu.2:41-51,10:17, 20; Rom.13:1-7; Titus 3:1; James 4:6-10

So what is the overall 'submission guide' for all believers? 5:21; Rom.13:1-7; Acts 4:13-22

We are all to submit to one another! Exception is commanded to violate God's Word!

Who is the ultimate example of submission? ICor.15:22-28; Lu.2:41-51

The ultimate example is Christ Himself. Submitting to parents, to the Father. Co-equal...

There are 3 verses in Eph.5 instructing wives (9 instructing husbands!). What's in 5:22? 5:24

Wives submit (rank under) to your own husbands, as (same as) to the Lord. All believers.

What is the explanation for this? 5:23; ITim.2:9-14

The husband is the head of the wife, as Christ is the head of the Church. It's God ordained What is an example of saved wife, unsaved husband? IPet.3:1-6

The godly wife submits quietly to him, and may win him without a word! Lord intervenes! What specific things are "older women" to carefully *avoid*? Titus 2:3

Be reverent in behavior, not malicious gossips, not enslaved to much wine.

What are "older women" to be doing? Titus 2:1-5

Temperate, dignified, sensible, faith, love, perseverance, teaching young women.
