What happens when a lie breaks our belt of truth? And the solution? Ps.32:1-7; Ps.51:1-9 We're open to attack and God's discipline! Solution...Repent, confess, and put the belt on! What is the next piece of armor God has given to us? 6:14b; IICor.5:21; Eph.4:24; IThess.5:8 It's the breastplate of righteousness. Christ put on this breastplate, Is.59:17, Mt.4:1-11 So how does the breastplate of righteousness become personal? 6:14b; IICor. 5:18-21; Gal. 2:20 This is recognizing that IN HIM, we have His righteousness! We are to live righteously! And how do we often fail to use His righteousness? IJn.1:5-10 When we live unrighteous, in unconfessed sin, we are open to demonic attack! Confess! Now what is the next piece of armor? 6:15; Isa.52:7; Rom.10:15; Lu.15:22; IICor.5:18-21 It is having shoes (readiness to move, travel) with the Gospel (good news) of Peace w/God! Describe this Peace. Jn.16:33; Rom.1:7, 8:6, 15:33, 16:20; IICor.13:11; Col.3:15; IIThess3:16 It is the peace between God and believers. It is our peace with others by being IN HIM! How does this peace manifest itself? Gal.5:22; IICor.12:11 It is a 'fruit of the Holy Spirit'! Comfort one another, agree with on another, live in peace! And how do we take this Gospel of Peace to the lost? 6:15; IPet.3:15 We take it by our 'walk', the way we live. Always ready to share the Gospel of Peace!
