

## Eph.6:17-24 ESV (emphasis added)

- <sup>17</sup> Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
- <sup>18</sup> **praying at all times in the Spirit**, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,
- <sup>19</sup> and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel,
- <sup>20</sup> for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.
- <sup>21</sup>So that you also may know how I am and what I am doing, Tychicus the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord will tell you everything.
- <sup>22</sup>I have sent him to you for this very purpose, that you may know how we are, and that he may encourage your hearts.
- <sup>23</sup> Peace be to the brothers, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- <sup>24</sup> Grace be with all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with love incorruptible.

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### **Praying at all times**

What is the next piece of armor? 6:17; Isa.59:15-18; IThess.5:8 The helmet of salvation. Protects the head, brain, the thoughts. Hope = confidence. Why does IThess.5:8 talk about the *hope* of salvation? IThess.5:8-11; Heb.12:1-3 It is our *confidence* in God's promise that we're destined for salvation, *not* wrath. No lie... What armor protects us from this mind attack? 6:17; Jn.6:37-39, 10:28-29; Phil.1:6; IPet.1:3-10 Our thoughts are protected by the promises in the written Word. Know it, believe it...! So why is the Sword of the Spirit so important? 6:17: Jn.17:17; Heb.4:12; Mt.4:4-11 Sanctify them in the truth, Your Word is truth. The Word is both a defense and a weapon! What is one of the most difficult uses of the sword for us? Rom.6:1-6, Gal.2:20; ICor.10:13 When the attack is from our flesh, our old nature. The enemy is me! My defense is Word! What is the next instruction? 6:18; Jude 20-21; Rom.8:26; Lu.18:1-8; IIIJn.2; James 5:16; It is to pray, in the Spirit, always, being persistent, make supplication for all the saints! And how does Paul close this 'armor' section? 6:19-20, 3:3; IICor.5:20; Acts 28:20 Also pray for me, to have bold words to proclaim the mystery of Gospel as I ought to!! What had Paul done for the Ephesian believers? 6:21-22 To encourage them, he sent Tychicus to them, beloved and faithful minister to tell of Paul.
