Predestined for adoption

What is absolutely true for those IN ADAM vs those IN CHRIST? ICor.15:22

In Adam all *die*, physically and spiritually. In Christ, all *live*, spiritually and physically!

What is also absolutely true for those who are IN CHRIST? Rom.8:1, 4:17-25; Ps.103:3

There is absolutely NO CONDEMNATION for those who are IN CHRIST! Imputation!

What has the Father done, in love, for those He chose? 1:4-5a; Ps.103:13

He, the Father, in love predestined us for adoption to Himself, as sons through Jesus...!

NOTE: Nowhere does Scripture teach that people are predestined to eternal condemnation!

Those who are condemned are so because of what? Jn.3:16-18, 19-21; Rom.3:9-20

Condemnation comes because they do not believe in the name of the only Son of God.

What is the sure indication of one who is chosen? Rom.8:14-17; Gal.5:18

It is one who is led by the Spirit of God. The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit...

And the purpose of His will, to the praise of His glorious grace is...? 1:6-7, 2:8-9

His will is to *bless us* in the Beloved. Beloved = Jesus! We are blessed by being *in Jesus*!

And what are *some* of these incredible blessings, being in Jesus? 1:7; Ps.103:2-4

We have redemption through His blood, and the forgiveness of our trespasses, by grace!

And how are these 'riches of His grace', (given to us), measured? 1:8, 1:18, 2:7, 3:8

They are lavished, riches, glorious, rich in mercy, immeasurable, unsearchable!!
